1 MEET THE MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER!

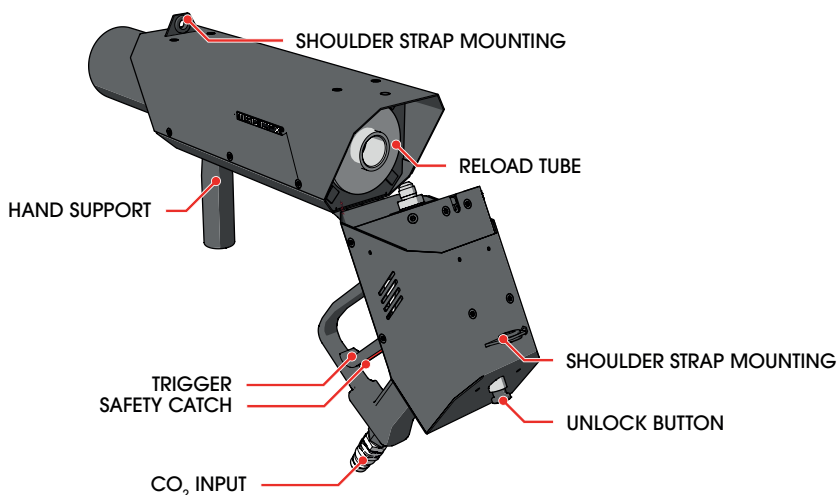
The MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER is a handheld gun-shaped device for safe shooting of CO₂, confetti, streamers or T-shirts into the air.

Before operation the MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER needs to be connected to a CO₂ cylinder. When the user squeezes the handle, the CO₂ is released from the barrel. The shot is accompanied by a strong hissing sound and a white plume of smoke will be visible from the barrel. Depending on the barrel content; confetti, streamers or a T-shirt will leave the barrel.

NOTICE

Visibility of the CO₂ effect can vary due to air humidity. The output will be more visible when there is high absolute air humidity.

1.5 PROJECTILES

The MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER can shoot confetti, streamers and T-shirts. The maximum output distance per shot depends on the speed the trigger is pulled and the type of projectile. Check the following table.

Type of projectile	Max. load per tube	Output distance
Metallic confetti	0,5 kg	12 m
Paper confetti	0,35 kg	12 m
Streamers	3 polybags	20 m
T-shirt	1 pc.	30 m

NOTICE

Wind and other weather circumstances will influence the output height and output distance of the confetti. The given values are estimated values.

2 SHOOT SAFELY!

The MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER has been designed and constructed in such a manner that it can be used safely. This applies to the use, the circumstances and the regulations as described in this documentation. Reading this documentation and following the instructions are therefore necessary for everyone who works with the MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER.

The MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER must be used in surroundings that:

- Have a stable temperature of between -15 and 100 °C.
- Have a relative humidity degree between 20% and 90% (non condensing).
- Are free of dust, corrosive gases and high concentrations of organic vapours.
- Are not situated in the vicinity of a source of vibration.

2.1 GENERAL SAFETY RULES

- Only authorised people may work with the MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER.
- Do not use the MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER if there are people or animals in the direct output.
- Make sure that children, unauthorised people and animals do not obtain access to the MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER.
- Do not remove any safeguards, safety caps and safety symbols.
- All required safety devices must be in good condition and function properly.
- Ensure sufficient lighting of the surroundings.
- Keep the workplace clean.

2.2 CO₂

The MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER uses liquid or gaseous CO₂ as input. The application of CO₂ involves serious risks. Make sure that you are well informed on these risks before installation and/or operation. Always use approved CO₂ cylinders, hoses and connectors. Always consult your CO₂ supplier for regulations and instructions on safe installation and use.

MAGIC FX is not liable for unsafe situations, accidents and damage that are the result of incorrect working with CO₂ gas and CO₂ cylinders.

⚠ WARNING

Inadequate installation and/or operation of a CO₂ powered machine and CO₂ cylinders can lead to death or serious injury. Always follow the instructions from this manual, from your CO₂ supplier and from local authorities.

2.3 INDOOR USE

The MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER is designed for outdoor use and use in well-ventilated indoor spaces. When used indoors, make sure you take the necessary preparations. These preparations could include, but are not limited to:

- Consulting your CO₂ supplier.
- Calculating the reduction of oxygen for the indoor space.
- Checking the location for spots where CO₂ could accumulate and taking preventive actions.
- Installing CO₂ monitoring devices that will warn for hazardous CO₂ levels.

⚠ DANGER

Do not use the MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER in poorly ventilated confined spaces. Exposure to high levels of CO₂ gas can cause symptoms like headache, nausea, loss of consciousness or even death.



2.4 NOISE LEVEL

The environmental noise level measured at 1 m (39.4 in) from the product is 110 dB(A). This level of noise is only reached during the short shooting instances. Therefore hearing protection is not necessary.

⚠ WARNING

Do not operate the MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER close to yourself or to others for a long period of time. If you experience any hearing loss or ringing in the ears, you should immediately stop using the unit.

2.6 PRECAUTIONS FOR OPERATION

⚠ WARNING

Using a damaged launcher can lead to serious injury and property damage. Always inspect the launcher thoroughly before operation.

⚠ WARNING

Do not trigger the launcher when opened. Triggering the launcher when opened causes a significant higher reactive force. This also results in the CO₂ leaving the launcher in an undesirable way. This can lead to serious injuries.

⚠ WARNING

Always hold the launcher firmly with two hands while in a stable standing position. When fired a reactive force is produced, causing a backlash vibration. This can lead to injuries when the launcher is released from the hands unintentionally or when the backlash causes the user to lose balance.

⚠ WARNING

Missing or obscured safety symbols on the machine can lead to death or serious injury. Make sure all safety symbols are correctly in place, see section 2.5.

NOTICE

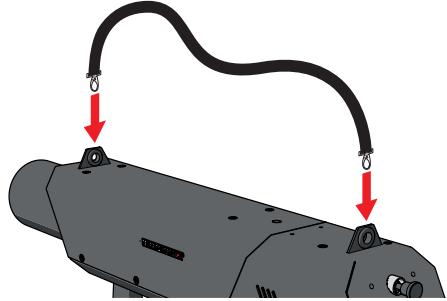
During operation electrostatic discharge can occur when the machine is touched. Prevent the discomfort of a possible static shock by wearing gloves.

3 LET'S SHOOT!

3.1 (DE)ATTACH THE SHOULDER STRAP

- 1 Attach the shoulder strap to the shoulder strap mounting holes on the launcher.

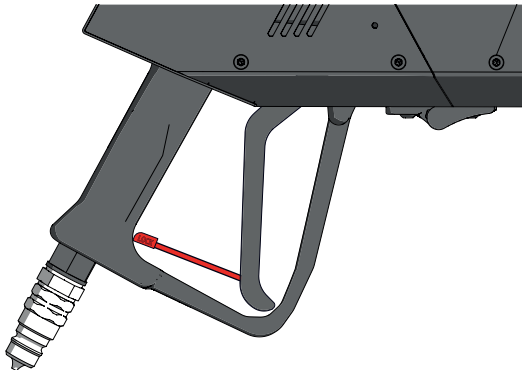
Make sure the shoulder strap is secured properly, the launcher can fall otherwise.



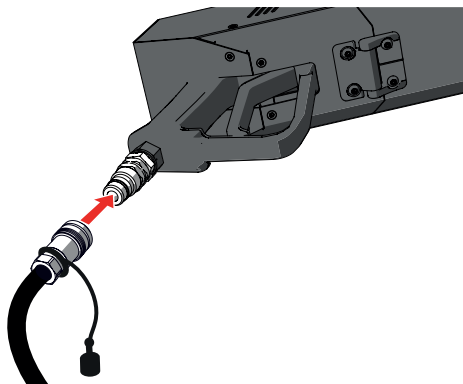
- 2 Deattach the shoulder strap by removing the shoulder strap out of the shoulder strap mounting holes.

3.2 CONNECT CO₂

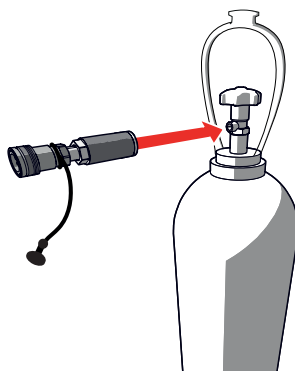
- 1 Make sure that the safety catch is in locking position.



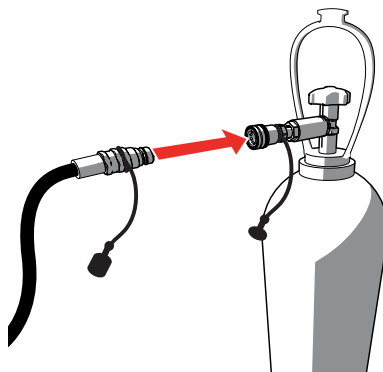

- 2** Connect the CO₂ hose to the CO₂ quick connector.



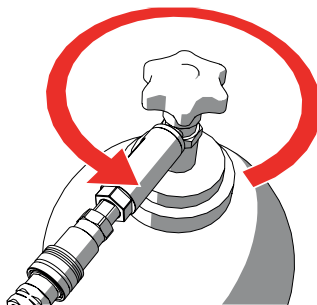

- 3** Connect the CO₂ Bottle to Hose Connector to a CO₂ cylinder.

- 4** Connect the CO₂ hose to the CO₂ Bottle to Hose Connector on the CO₂ cylinder.

- 5 Open the CO₂ cylinder.

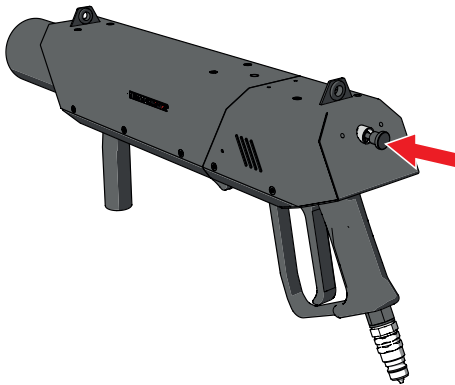


3.3 (RE)LOAD WITH TEXTILES

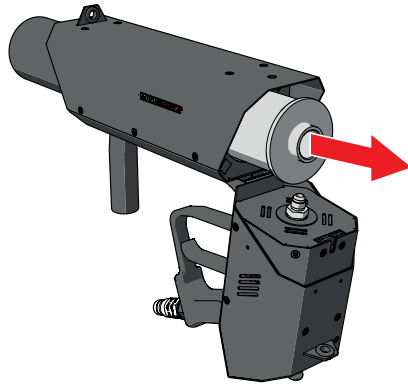
⚠ WARNING

Filling the tube with products than otherwise specified, can cause serious injury or death.

- 1 Push the unlock button to open the launcher.

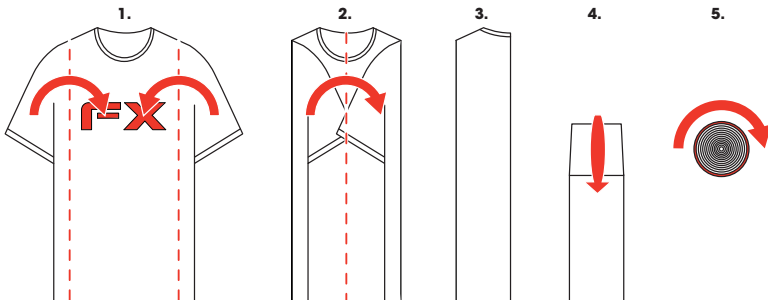

- 2** Remove the tube from the barrel.

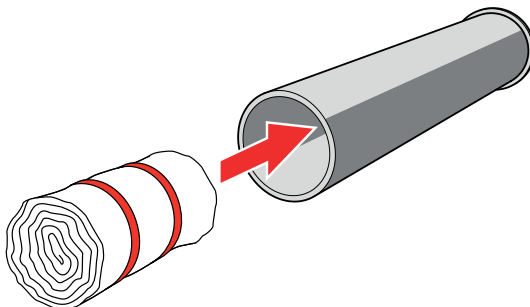

- 3** Make sure to fold T-shirts correctly before shooting.

1. Fold the sides of the T-shirt to the center.
2. Fold the T-shirt in half.
3. Lay the T-shirt flat.
4. Start rolling the T-shirt from the neck into a light roll.
When done, pull the opposite side to ensure the tightness of the roll.
5. Fixate the roll by using rubber bands.

- 4 Fill the tube with soft and safe textiles like t-shirts, scarfs or flags.



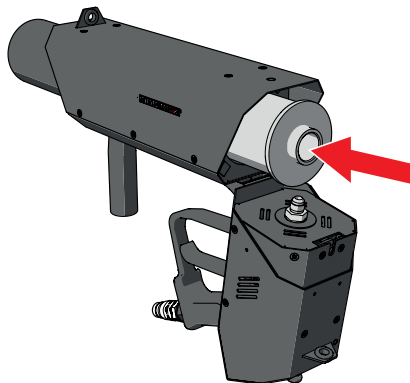
NOTICE

You can use the launcher with an empty tube. When the tube is empty, CO₂ will shoot in the air and a white plume of smoke will be visible.

NOTICE

Place the empty tube in the launcher if you want to use the launcher only for a CO₂ effect.

- 5 Place the tube in the barrel.

- 6 Close the launcher.

⚠ WARNING

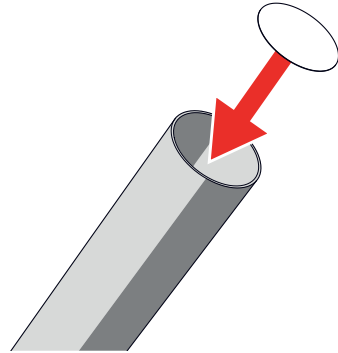
Make sure to completely close the launcher. Failure to do so could lead to injury.

3.4 (RE)LOAD WITH CONFETTI AND/OR STREAMERS

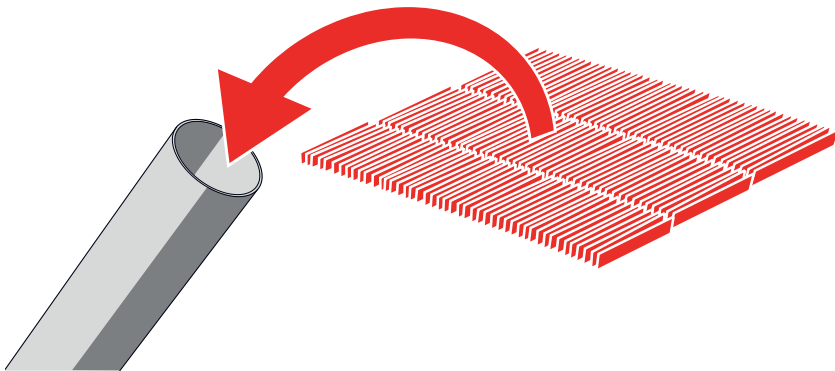
- 1 Remove the tube from the barrel, see Section 3.2, steps 1 and 2.

- 2 Place a lifting core in the bottom of the tube.

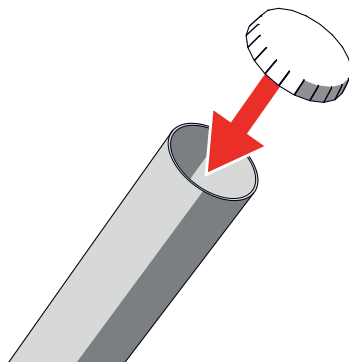
Make sure the lifting core lies flat and closes off the hole in the tube!



- 3 Fill the tube with confetti and/or streamers. The maximum dimensions of the streamers may be 5 m x 0,85 cm or 10 m x 1,5 cm.

- 4** Place an end sticker on top of the tube.

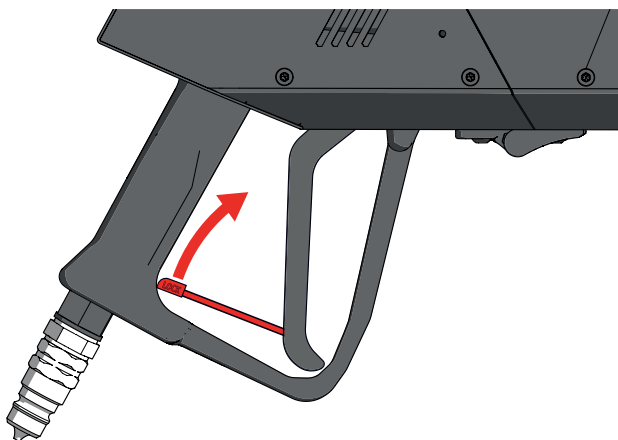

- 5** Place the tube in the barrel and close the launcher, see Section 3.2, step 5 and 6.

3.5 SHOOT

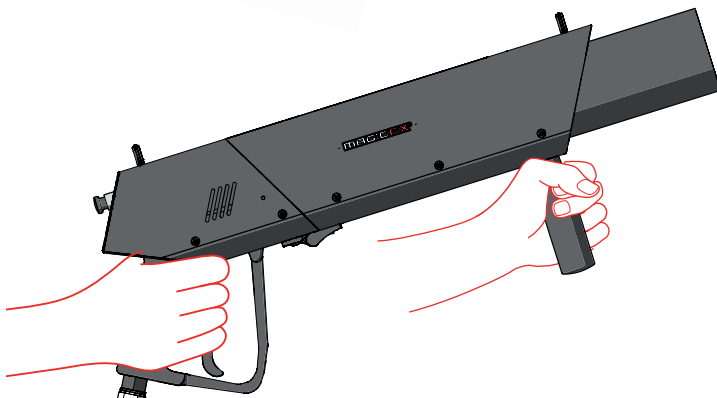
- 1** Carefully walk to the desired shooting position.

- 2** Unlock the safety catch.

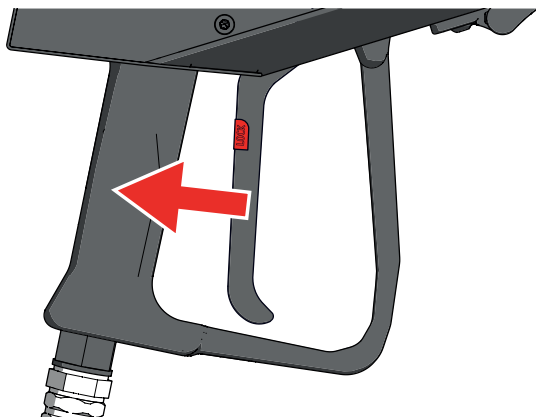

- 3** Firmly hold with two hands and aim above the audience.

Make sure there are no persons or animals in the direct output of the MAGICFX® CO2LAUNCHER.

- 4** When it's time to shoot, squeeze the handle.



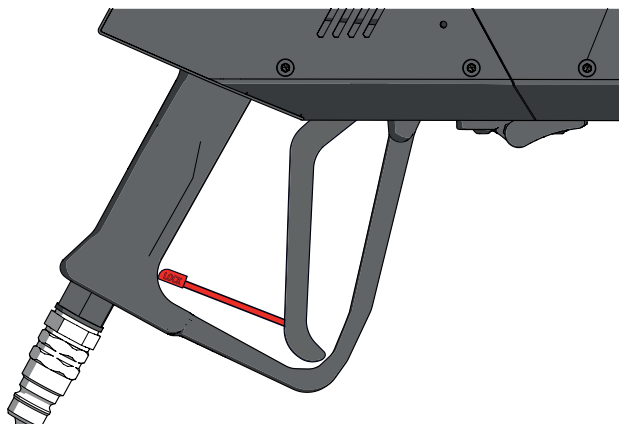
NOTICE

The faster you squeeze the handle, the faster the projectile exits the launcher.

5 Enjoy the view.

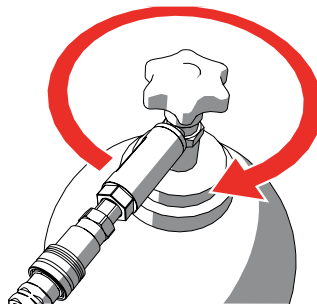
6 Release the handle to stop shooting.

7 Place the safety catch back in locking position.

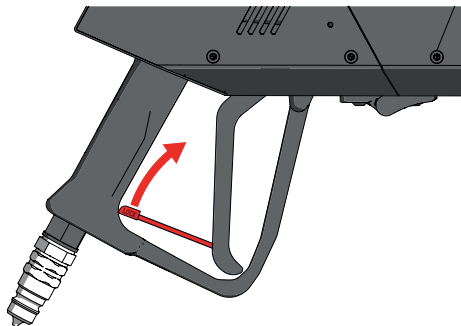

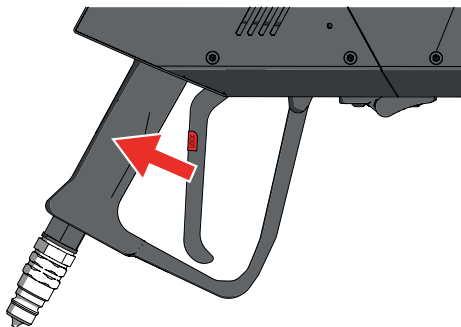
1 Close the connected CO₂ cylinder.



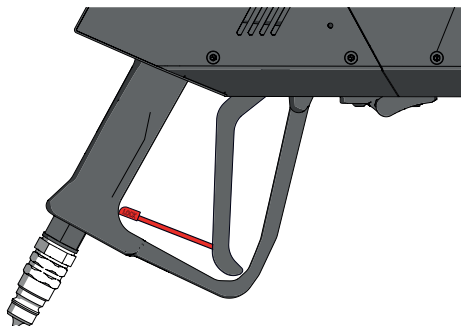
